


Overview

Linking Your Accounts in SciENCv

1. Click your **username** in the upper right corner of the menu bar to open **NCBI Account Settings**.
2. On the NCBI Account Settings screen, under Linked Accounts, click **Add account**.





3. Search for the account name you'd like to link and then **follow the instructions** for authentication.



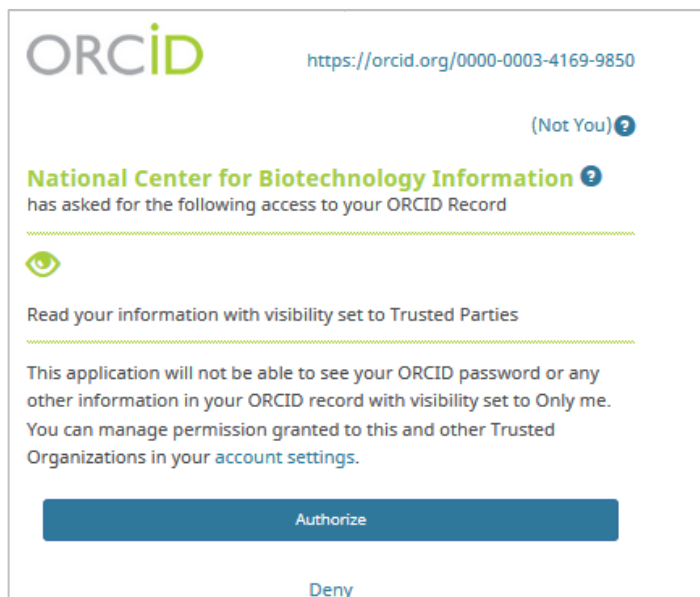
